1 x Safety Equipment Requirements. **Please read before leaving the UK.**

2 x Gold Wristband General Entry and Inside Paddock **(Crew, Relatives and Friends).**

2 x Yellow Wristbands General Entry Paddock **PLUS PIT LANE** (Crew Only).

2 x Orange Wristbands General Entry Paddock, **PLUS PIT LANE AND TRACK** (Drivers and Crew Only).

1 x Entry List **(Please read this prior to the event, with a combined race your race number may have changed from normal).**

Vehicle Passes, to be displayed on vehicle at all times for entry into inside paddocks.

ARE NOT INCLUDED WITH THIS PACK. SEE SEPARATE E-MAIL

You will receive an e-mail Spa Six Hour Vehicle Pass. This will come in a PDF Format

THIS MUST BE PRINTED BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE UK and given to the steward at Blanchimont Gate. Print the number of copies that corresponds to the number of vehicles you require passes for. In exchange you will be given the correct number of passes according to the function of your vehicle. Remember if you have a vehicle preparer he will need to receive a copy of this e-mail or he may be refused entry.

Paddock Parking - See accompanying Paddock Plan

Entry to the circuit: Wednesday 12th September from 20.00 to 22.30,

Thursday 13th September from 07.30 to 22.00, Friday September 14th 07.30 – 22.00

Scrutineering: NEW PROCEDURE At sign on you will receive two forms one for the inspection of your equipment, (Race Suit, Boots, Gloves, Helmet etc) and one for the inspection of your car.

Equipment will be inspected from 08.00 – 19.00 on Thursday 13th September and Friday 14th 08.00 – till 90 minutes before your race time. Inspection of equipment will take place in room 131 1st Floor of F1 Pit Building.

Inspection of your car Thursday 13th September 09.00 -19.00, Friday 14th September 08.00 -10.00

Compulsory Driver Briefing: Friday 14th September 09.30 Failure to attend will result in a 150 Euro fine. If you are going to be on track at the time of your briefing please speak to the people at sign on to advise when you can attend.

Your timetable for the HSCC Closed Wheel Races is as follows:

Friday 14th September: Qualifying 11.20 – 11.50

Saturday 15th September: Race 1 10.40 – 11.10

Sunday 16th September: Race 2 13.55 – 14.25

The grid for Race 2 will be made from the finishing order of Race 1, with non-finishers completing the grid in the order of retirement.

Testing: Testing is available on Thursday 13th September and is to be booked at the circuit. Go to room 115 1st Floor of F1 Pit Building. Room opens at 8.00am. Payment is cash only and sessions are 200 Euros for a 45 minute session. Noise limit is 103dba dynamic with a static test of 107dba. You are not allowed passengers or instructors in the car.

Transponders: Please have your transponder number with you as it will be recorded at driver sign on. Only AMB (My Laps, Tranx) transponders will be used at this event. If you do not have a transponder or have a Chronolec Transponder an AMB transponder will be provided free of charge in exchange for the driver's race licence.

Please note the HSCC Race has a noise limit of 108dba dynamic, so remember to bring your silencers
