OFFICIALS' STANDING INSTRUCTIONS

- ADMISSION** Entry to the circuit can only be gained by showing/handing in your ticket. All Officials will be sent a guest ticket which must be used on or before the first race commences. Please **don't ask** as we don't have any spare tickets. The ticket is valid for all three days.
- SIGN-ON TIME** **SEE OFFICIALS' SHEET**
- OFFICIALS' NOTES** Armbands, if required, will be given out with copy of the programme and your name will be entered in the raffle. Winners will be announced during the day. All marshals must report to their respective chiefs who will be in the marshals' signing-on area. After signing-on and reporting to your chief proceed to your allocated post at least 30 minutes before the start of practice and 20 minutes before racing. **AT THE CONCLUSION OF BOTH PRACTICE AND RACING ALL MARSHALS MUST REMAIN AT THEIR POSTS UNTIL STOOD DOWN BY THE OFFICIAL COURSE CAR.** Cars must be parked well away from the circuit and observers should ensure that this is carried out to their satisfaction. For parking instructions for this event please see notes below. The circuit have requested special arrangements as they want to make the infield as car-free as possible
- SAFETY** **MARSHALS MUST AT ALL TIMES**
- Stand as far back from the track as their duties will allow and not set foot on the track unless instructed to by the Observer in charge of the post.
 - Make full use of the protective barriers or such means of protection as are available.
 - Never stand with their backs to approaching traffic unless required to do so by definition of their duty.
 - Never stand in more than groups of two.
 - Cameras must not be carried or used.
- REFRESHMENTS** These are available from the Chequers from 7:15am
- JUNIORS** All Officials under the age of 18 must return an indemnity signed by the parent or guardian to the Chief Marshal giving them permission to officiate at the event.

Marshals' Camping is on the 40 Acre Field. It is only available from Friday 23rd August –Tuesday 27th August 2019.

It will be open at the following times:

MONDAY 26 th August	There will be NO camping admission

The campsite will be open until 12.00 on Tuesday 27th August 2019

NO Noise after 21.00hrs each night – No Open FIRES – No Animals.

Toilet and Shower Facilities will be on the camping site.

Please ensure you have a valid ticket to gain entry to the circuit.

SIGN-ON WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: Signing-on for Marshals will be in the 4 x 4 rally hut (on the outside the circuit behind Deer Leap Flag Post). Entry will be via the East Gate.

Senior Officials, Race Admin, Race Control, Pits, Start Line & Paddock/Assembly will park in the Paddock in the Parc Ferme area.

PLEASE NOTE - NO PRIVATE CARS WILL BE ALLOWED ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK UNLESS THEY HAVE THE APPROPRIATE CAR PASS. Infield parking is available at Cascades behind the Armco, and at some points as advised by the Chief Marshal. All other parking to be on the outside of the circuit.

NO PARKING IN FRONT OF THE FOGARTY MOSS CENTRE. Parking for Avenue, Knickerbrook, Clay Hill and Lakeside posts will be at Cascades. Please keep the escape road clear. Parking for Water Tower, Druids and Warwick Bridge at Druids.

IF YOU ARE TURNED AWAY BY THE PADDOCK GATE STAFF PLEASE DO NOT GET UPSET WITH THEM AS THEY ARE ONLY DOING THEIR JOB.
