## Marshals' and Officials' Final Instructions

A warm welcome and thank you for volunteering for our meeting. Enclosed are two entry tickets, there is no separate car pass. We don't have to tell you how much we appreciate your efforts and we want to do everything possible to ensure that you enjoy your day with us. If you have any comments or criticisms of the day, please let one of the senior officials know. If you have asked for a particular post or to be paired with another marshal, we will do our best but please bear with us if, for operational reasons, we have to move you.

There will be a bonfire and fireworks show from 5.15pm on Sunday 3 November after racing has ended, the fireworks will be set off on Copse banking; the fireworks viewing areas and bonfire are sited behind the support paddock.

Camping is at Winterhills, which is behind the college building near Copse Corner. This is approached by turning left inside the main gate and following the perimeter road towards Silverstone UTC, from where there will be access through the vehicle gates (gate 5) on the left hand side directly after the college. Camping is free for marshals, showers and toilets will be provided. There are two power hook-up points on the fence back on to the circuit one near the gate and one further along for caravans. The campsite will be open from 12pm on Friday and will close at 09.00 on Monday.

The Pit Stop Café will be open on both Saturday from 07.30 to 21.00 and Sunday from 07.30 – 18.30 offering meals for anyone staying on site and there will also be a small bar open in the diner.
