WHAT WE ARE DOING TO KEEP EVERYONE SAFE VISITOR INFORMATION

In line with current Government guidance, we intend to reopen for day visitors at race meetings from Saturday 11 July 2020. A day out at one of our venues will feel a little different to before, but all the changes we are introducing have the safety of visitors, and that of our staff, as our top priority.

Until at least the end of July, visitors can only come for the day - no camping is available for the public.

This summary explains the new operations and safety measures we have put in place to protect you and our employees, and to ensure our venues are COVID-secure.

BEFORE ARRIVAL

- · Visitors are advised to check our website and social media pages for latest information before leaving home
- · All tickets must be purchased in advance to quarantee entry
- · Visitors must not attend if they are displaying any symptoms associated with COVID-19 or are required to self-isolate

ON ARRIVAL

- Signage will be in place for vehicle parking arrangements
- · Signage at venue entrances will reinforce social distancing measures and require visitors to return home if they have symptoms
- Advance-only tickets will minimise gueues
- Hand sanitiser will be available for visitor use at entrances
- Staff scanning tickets will be behind a screen or have appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

MAINTAINING SOCIAL DISTANCING AND VISITOR SAFETY

- Race circuits are huge open areas of land. Nevertheless. we will limit capacity to ensure visitors can easily socially distance
- · Where grandstands are open, seating plans will be reconfigured to allow for social distancing
- · Signage will inform visitors of key messages and instructions, including what to do if they start to display any COVID-19 symptoms and how to maintain social distance
- Public access to all working areas (e.g. paddocks, pit lanes and garages) is prohibited until further notice
- Walkways may be one-way or closed where recommended social distancing is otherwise not possible
- Some facilities may not be open at all race meetings, for example children's playgrounds

RESTAURANTS AND FOOD SERVERIES

- · We will offer a takeaway service with a greater emphasis on 'Grab and Go' items to reduce queuing times
- · Food and drink will predominantly be served in disposable (recyclable) containers with plenty of bins available
- · Signage will reinforce social distancing within queues
- · New hygiene screens have been installed at service counters
- · Self-service buffets and salad bars will be closed until further notice
- · Cutlery and condiments will be given to visitors with their meal, or on request, rather than left in open areas
- Payments will need to be 'contactless' (where possible)
- · All members of catering staff will be wearing appropriate PPE
- Visitors will be welcome to bring their own food and drink to the venue

TOILETS

- We will be deploying enhanced cleaning measures and disinfecting high-frequency touch points such as flush handles
- · Sanitising sprays will be available so that visitors can take their own extra precautions too, if they wish
- · Signage and floor markers will be in place to enable social distancing in queues

HYGIENE AND CLEANING

- · Enhanced cleaning measures will be in force to disinfect high-frequency touch points, such as service counters and
- Hand sanitiser dispensers will be available around each venue for visitors to use
- All visitors are asked to uphold the highest possible hygiene standards – to be supported by signage around each venue
- MSV employees will be following additional procedures to keep our visitors safe and stay safe themselves



HSCC SEASON READY TO START

The Historic Sports Car Club's 2020 season will make a belated start on the Brands Hatch Grand Prix circuit at this weekend's Legends of Brands Super Prix meeting.

Three months later than planned due to COVID-19, the HSCC season will start in style on one of Europe's finest race tracks with a full weekend covering 18 races and over 320 entries for cars spanning four decades of racing history. The event will be run in strict adherence to government and Motorsport UK guidelines and it is clear that there is a huge appetite among competitors to get racing again.

Many of the HSCC's championships and series will get their 2020 season underway and entries are strong right across the programme. At the head of the action are two races for the cars form the HSCC Historic Formula 2 Championship and they will set a stunning pace around the sweeps of the Grand Prix circuit.

In a superbly competitive Formula 2 field, likely contenders include Marc Devis and father and son Mike and Matthew Wrigley in March 782s, Mark Charteris and Mark Dwyer in March 742s, Andrew Smith and series newcomer Callum Grant in March 79Bs and David Tomlin in his rare but rapid Motul M1.

The biggest grid of the weekend is due to be a magnificent 40-car field for the Historic Touring Car Championship as a gaggle of American V8s take on Ford Anglias, Lotus Cortinas and Mini Coopers. Former F3000 racer Dave Coyne heads the Ford Mustang entry, while 2003 Le Mans winner Guy Smith already has two wins to his credit this season in the Lotus Cortina he is racing alongside the similar car of his father Peter. Other quick Cortinas will be handled by Roger Stanford, Ollie Taylor and John Spiers, while Jonathan Lewis tops the Mini pack.

Two half-hour races will get the Vital Equipment HSCC Thundersports series off to a great start with a strong entry topped by the sensational McLaren M8F of Dean Forward. Notable rivals include Tony Sinclair (Lola T292), Jonathan Mitchell (Chevron B19), John Spiers (Osella PA3) while Chris Snowdon (Tiga SC81) tops the Sports 2000 class.

The opening grid for the Aurora Trophy will be shared with the Classic Formula 3 cars and it is hard to see anyone rivalling the searing pace of Michael Lyons (Formula 5000 Lola T400). Greg Thornton (Chevron B24) will head the chase along with a gaggle of quick F2 cars including Simon Fish (Chevron B42) and Mike Bletsoe-Brown (Chevron B27). Among the Classic F3 pack, team mates David Thorburn and Fraser Gray (Ralt RT3s) and young Benn Tilley (March 743) will be key contenders.

A fabulous field of 36 cars will line up for the combined Historic and Classic Formula Ford 2000 races on Saturday and there is a gaggle of front-runners including Ben

Stiles and Tony Hancock in the later Classic cars. However, the Historic division is wide open in the absence of several usual pacesetters. Renowned race car designer Adrian Reynard has one of his own designs from 1979 while the Royales of Andrew Smith, Drew Cameron and Wil Arif should be quick in the Historics.

A typically strong grid will contest the opening two rounds of the Silverline Historic Formula Junior Championship and the Brabhams of Cam Jackson, Mark Shaw and Richard Wilson should top the 34-car field. Michael Hibberd plans to give a Lotus 22 its first race for 50 years while his son Andrew switches to the family's Lola Mk2 to head the front-engined division.

Running over 40 minutes on Saturday is the Guards Trophy and this has another strong entry of sports-racing and GT cars. The timeless Chevron B6 and B8 design is to the fore, capped by the cars of Andy Newall, Philip Nelson, Hugh Colman, Westie Mitchell and Charles Allison. However, the combination of Michael Lyons and Anthony Reid in a Lenham P69 could really upset the Chevron applecart. Meanwhile, the GT pack is headed by the TVR Griffith of John Spiers, the AC Cobra of Mark Garritt and a gaggle of rapid Lotus Elans.

Cam Jackson has a shot at scooping six race wins over the weekend as he'll tackle four Formula Ford races on Sunday with double headers for the Classic and Historic categories. In the Historic division, he's aiming for a third title in a third different car as he switches to the unfashionable March 709 of Ross Drybrough. Jackson's rivals include Matt Wrigley, Rob Wainwright, Pierre Livingstone and Linton Stutley.

For the Classic races, Jackson moves to his Van Diemen RF80 and will go head-to-head with the similar car of Richard Tarling as well as the Royale RP29 of category veteran Rick Morris. Henry Chart (Van Diemen RF81) and Mark Harrison (Lola T540E) are other front-runners. Joining the Classic Formula Fords on a split grid will be the cars in the Historic Formula 3 Championship for the 1-litre cars of the late 1960s and early 1970s. Reigning champion Simon Armer (March 703) heads the field along with cousins Jeremy and Jason Timms and Michael Scott in his Brabham BT28.

Two races for Road Sports are at the heart of Sunday's racing with a magnificent total of more than 60 cars across the 70s and Historic Road Sports Championships. Current champion Jeremy Clark (Lotus Elan) tops the 70s field but can expect fierce opposition from John Williams (Porsche 911SC), Dave Karaskas (TVR 3000M) and particularly the Morgan Plus 8 of Kevin Kivlochan.


Kivlochan will then switch to his mighty AC Cobra to open his defence of the Historic Road Sports title. His big threat will come from former champion John Davison (Lotus Elan), back after sitting out most of the 2019 season, while Neil Merry (Sunbeam Tiger), Ian Burford (Ginetta G4) and Jonathan Rose (Lotus Elan) are all contenders.

BLUE FLAG WAVED: Another competitor is trying to overtake.

YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY: Danger – Slow down, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG WAVED: Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG DOUBLE WAVED: Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN
ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD
DISPLAYING SC: Means that a Safety car
is on track, slow down, no overtaking.
Yellow Flag signals may also be
accompanied by flashing yellow lights as

YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY: Warning you are approaching an area

YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED: There is a slippery surface area within this sector.

GREEN FLAG: All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.

RED FLAG: Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.

WHITE FLAG STATIONARY: A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

WHITE FLAG WAVED: A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect and may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.
