OFFICIALS' STANDING INSTRUCTIONS

ADMISSION	Entry to the circuit can only be gained by showing/handing in your ticket. All Officials will be sent a guest ticket which must be used on or before the first race commences. Please don't ask as we don't have any spare tickets. The ticket is valid for all three days.
SIGN-ON TIME	SATURDAY 07.30 to 08.15 (for 09.00 start) SUNDAY 10.30 to 11.15 (for 12.05 start) MONDAY 07.00 to 07.45 (for 08.30 start)
OFFICIALS' NOTES	Please remember to submit your Officials Declaration to Margaret Simpson prior to the event. This will be available to download from the HSCC Website or alternatively you can request it to be e-mailed to you by contacting alan@hsc.org.uk . PPE (See Note Below) will be given out with copy of the programme at the attendance check/Post Allocation in the Old Accessory Shop in the Paddock. After reporting proceed to your allocated post at least 30 minutes before the start of practice and 20 minutes before racing. AT THE CONCLUSION OF BOTH PRACTICE AND RACING ALL MARSHALS MUST REMAIN AT THEIR POSTS UNTIL STOOD DOWN BY THE OFFICIAL COURSE CAR. Cars must be parked well away from the circuit and observers should ensure that this is carried out to their satisfaction. For parking instructions for this event please see notes below. The circuit have requested special arrangements as they want to make the infield as car-free as possible

Reminders of current Marshaling Practice

Incidents Upon the request of the Clerk of the Course you should approach a stranded vehicle face on and at a safe distance to observe the thumbs up that is required from a driver to indicate all is well.

If you do not get a clear signal then intervention vehicles will be deployed either under Safety car or a Red Flag Race Stoppage

Do not touch or enter a vehicle unless you have the correct PPE

Do attend to fires, direct drivers and only assist pushing where practicable and PPE is used.

PPE We will provide face coverings, spare gloves, hand sanitiser for your own personal use. As required most of you will have your marshalling gloves masks on post to be worn as you see fit. Marshals and officials in closer contact with competitors are recommended and should be changed when they become moist based on manufactures advice. Don't forget to dispose correctly (preferably take home with you).

If you feel unwell during the day: Contact Race Control and advise. Return equipment where possible and leave the circuit as soon as practicable. Keep the Chief Marshal advised of updates to condition after event – especially if COVID-19 symptoms

Other Points

Maintain social distance Working within the current guidelines. and wash hands regularly (where practical)

Reports: Phone or radio, any incidents on track.

PRCs will not be signed at the event. Please record the details of your attendance and this will be checked with Chief Marshals if required

JUNIORS All Officials under the age of 18 must return an indemnity signed by the parent or guardian to the Chief Marshal giving them permission to officiate at the event.

PLEASE NOTE - NO PRIVATE CARS TO REMAIN IN THE PADDOCK UNLESS YOU ARE WORKING IN RACE CONTROL, PIT OR PADDOCK. Infield parking is available at Cascades behind the Armco, and at some points as advised by the Chief Marshal. All other parking to be on the outside of the circuit.

NO PARKING IN FRONT OF THE FOGARTY MOSS CENTRE. Parking for Avenue, Knickerbrook, Clay Hill and Lakeside posts will be at Cascades. Please keep the escape road clear. Parking for Water Tower, Druids and Warwick Bridge at Druids.

IF YOU ARE TURNED AWAY BY THE PADDOCK GATE STAFF PLEASE DO NOT GET UPSET WITH THEM AS THEY ARE ONLY DOING THEIR JOB.
