

## REPORT: HSCC Brands Hatch Super Prix

The Historic Sports Car Club's Legends of Brands Hatch Superprix delivered an outstanding three days of historic race action on both the Indy and Grand Prix circuits at the famous Kent venue (9-11 July).

In the Classic Formula Fords Cam Jackson won the opener relatively clearly from Henry Chart and Ben Tinkler but in the later race Chart really took the battle to Jackson. In fact, Jackson looked to be in trouble when he found oil at Paddock and slithered through the gravel and dropped back to fifth. But the race was red flagged, and the grid for the restart was taken back a lap, which put Jackson back at the front.

Chart matched him from the restart, and it was only a final lap spin at Stirling's for Chart that really settled the matter for Jackson, as Tinkler headed Jordan Harrison for a second and Chart dropped to fourth.
