Brands Hatch – 11th July 2021

A welcome return to the Brands Hatch Super Prix and the GP circuit.

John Davison took pole ahead of the Cobra by over a second and Rupert Ashdown in Kermit a credible third.

The Cobra (frustratingly for John) took the lead into Paddock Hill bend and despite John having fastest lap of the race and also a red flag to get a second bite at the cherry, he could not find a way passed the KeKi Cobra. This lead to a super close finish in the race, with the Cobra taking the flag by 0.701 of a second.

Rupert Ashdown took third overall and his first ever podium finish, something that I am sure will be repeated in the future. Frazer and Jonathan Rose, both in elans had a super finish with Jonathan ahead by only 0.53 seconds. Simon King in the Plus 8 Morgan was also hot on the heels of Mark Godfrey in the Ginetta G4, with Mark taking the place by 1.021 of a second.

Another close squabble was for P13, 14 & 15 with Adrian Gilbert's elan securing P13 ahead of Johan's TVR by 0.403, who was in turn ahead of Colin Sharp in the TR4 by a mere 0.145.

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Mark Richardson in the wonderful AC Ace, VPL442 had a superb battle with Guy Grant in the Grantura with Guy edging ahead by 0.325.

Subject: 2020 seat belts

Dear team

I was challenged by a competitor at Brands Hatch when I questioned the life expiry of his harness, as he thought there was a one-year life extension for harnesses (i.e., a 2020 harness is still valid) in the same way that there is one for seats. Please note that this is a separate issue to MSUK's five-year life extension to FIA 8853-2016 harnesses used in non-international events, which will all have a current validity until at least 2022 anyway, regardless of their five year extension.

For the avoidance of doubt, when you are next eMailing to or communicating with our body of competitors or drafting individual Championship newsletters, I should be grateful if you would make it plain to all that all 2020 belts are now out-of-validity.
