

THE SILVERSTONE FINALS

The championship season for the Historic Sports Car Club will conclude in style at Silverstone this weekend with a bumper 18-race programme for the annual Finals Meeting on the national circuit..

Cam Jackson, Horatio Fitz-Simon and Tom McArthur will settle the Historic Formula Ford title across three races at Silverstone. The third race is the replacement for a race lost

to two red flags at Brands Hatch in July. Jackson won the title in 2018 and '19 but didn't set out to do a full season this year and has missed the last four races at Oulton Park and Mallory Park. McArthur, meanwhile, missed four early season races but has won four on the bounce in the Hadfield-tended Titan Mk4.

Fitz-Simon, in his first full season of racing, has been a consistent scorer with his Speedsport Merlyn Mk20 with points from all 13 races. However, he has yet to score a win and is the only one with points to drop this weekend as the best 14 scores will count.

If Jackson can score 50 points across three races, which could be two wins or two seconds and a sixth, he will be champion for the third time.

Another championship to be settled is 70s Road Sports were a three-way battle between Will Plant, Gary Thomas and Jim Dean will finally be resolved. Heading to Silverstone it is advantage Plant but nothing can be taken for certain in the 25-minute race on Saturday afternoon.

Plant will be backed up by his father Richard in another Morgan Plus 8 while Thomas (Lotus 7) will be the man to beat in Class D and Dean fields his Lotus Europa in class C. Leading contenders in the overall contest include John Williams (Porsche 911SC) and Steve Skipworth in another rapid Lotus Europa.

Still to be finally resolved is the Classic Formula Ford 1600 Championship and though Cam Jackson has already won Class B for the older cars, the battle among the later cars is still just open. Jordan

Harrison certainly has the upper hand after a mighty season in his Lola T540E. Rick Morris still has a slim chance of beating Harrison to the title, but it would need the Lola driver to have a very tough weekend for Morris to nip ahead at the last gasp. Back on the grid and sure to be in the thick of the action will be Henry Chart while Adrian Reynard makes a welcome return to the series in the car he first built as a one-off special back in 1973, at the very beginning of the Reynard racing car story.

Rather more powerful single seaters will contest the concluding two races of the Aurora Trophy with the concurrent Geoff Lees Trophy cars joining the grid. A good line-up of Formula 5000s will be headed by the Chevron B37 of Neil Glover while the best of the two-litre cars could well be the March 742 of Mark

Charteris. In the Geoff Lees Trophy, for the cars of the 1980s, the Ralt RT4 of Rory Smith will be very quick.

To wrap up a tremendous season for Historic Formula Ford 2000, another bumper grid will contest two more races. Graham Fennimore has already settled the title but the battle for second between Ian Pearson And Benn Simms is currently separated by a single point.

Former champion Andrew Park will re-join the grid along with Fennymore for what is sure to be a fantastic conclusion to a brilliant season. Elsewhere in the field, Paul Allen makes an overdue debut in his ex-Callum Grant Delta T78 and teenager Molly Dodd looks to continue her tremendous form in her Royale RP27.

The Historic Formula Junior season concludes with a strong grid covering both front and rear-engined cars and it is Nic Carlton-Smith who will head to Silverstone as the newly crowned champion following the recent pair of races at Spa. Horatio Fitz-Simon doubles up from the Formula Ford grid to race the Speedsport

Lotus 22 his Formula Junior debut while the similar car of Clive Richards should set the overall pace. Among the front-engined cars Nick Taylor and John Arnold will pit their Elva 100s against the U2 Mk2 of Ray Mallock.

The Classic Formula 3 Championship concludes with a double header and a very good grid includes the quick Chevron of Richard Trott, the Ralt RT3 of David Thorburn and the Lola T670 of Anthony Hancock. However, they will all have their hands full trying to match the pace of 2021 champion Andrew Smith in his March 783. Murray Shepherd in his Van Diemen RF82 heads the concurrent Classic Formula Ford 2000 division.

a bumper 27-car grid of sports and GT cars from up to the end of the 1960s. Although the title is already settled in favour of John Davison, a fine grid include more quick Lotus Elans, a gaggle of Morgans and the AC Cobra of Nigel Griffiths. John Shaw, Tim Pearce and Simon King are all quick Morgan racers while the strong Lotus Elan contingent includes Robert Rowe, Barry Ashdown, Adrian Gilbert and Chris Merrick.

The Historic Touring Car Championship has two races on Sunday with a fair grid topped by the returning Dan Williamson in his Ford Falcon. He faces another Falcon in the hands of Tim Scott-Andrews and the Mustangs of Peter Hallford and Jason Green,

while newly-crowned champion Mike Gardiner heads the two-litre cars with His Lotus Cortina. Neil Wood will be out to try and topple Gardiner this time around after a tremendous battle at Mallory Park recently.

Running over a 40-minute duration on Sunday is the final race in the Guards Trophy season with newly-crowned champion Andy Newall heading the field in his Chevron B6. Similar cars for Phillip Nelson and Jonathan Gomm will head the pursuit of Newall along with two rapid Lenhams in the hands of Simon Jackson and his son Dominic and Mark Dwyer. In the GT pack, the rapid Lotus Elans of John Davison and Michael Schryver will surely set the pace.



FLAG/LIGHT SIGNALS



BLUE FLAG STATIONARY:

Another competitor is following close behind.

BLUE FLAG WAVED:

Another competitor is trying to overtake.



YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY:

Danger – Slow down, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG WAVED:

Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS WAVED:

Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD DISPLAYING SC:

Means that a Safety car is on track, slow down, no overtaking.

Yellow Flag signals may also be accompanied by flashing yellow lights as a repeat warning.



GREEN FLAG:

All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY:

Warning you are approaching an area with a slippery surface

YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED:

There is a slippery surface area within this sector.



RED FLAG:

Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.



WHITE FLAG STATIONARY:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

WHITE FLAG WAVED:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track..



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect (i.e. track limits) and may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.



BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK FLAG:

Displayed with white number. Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver, call into pits immediately.



BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED:

End of race.
