LIVE TIMING:

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THE QUEEN'S JUBILEE AT CADWELL PARK

The fabulous three dimensional circuit of Cadwell Park in Lincolnshire is the destination for the next instalment of the Historic Sports Car Club's 2022 racing season with the annual Wolds Trophy.

On a weekend that incorporates celebrations of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, there will be tremendous racing across two days here at Cadwell Park with eight races after qualifying on Saturday and a further 12 races right through Sunday.

PAUL LAWRENCE PREVIEWS THE ACTION





First out on Saturday afternoon for the opening race of their double-header weekend are contenders in the Historic Formula Ford 2000 Championship and it is Benn Simms who heads the field after a mighty five wins from six races to date this year.

Last time out at Silverstone, when tyre choice was tricky, it was current champion Graham Fennymore who brought Simms's winning sequence to at least a temporary halt.

Fennymore will aim for more at Cadwell Park in a grid that also includes the increasingly competitive Ollie Roberts, young Ben Glasswell, Lee Bankhurst in his Royale RP30 and Adrian Reynard, the man responsible for many of the cars on the grid.

Four races will cater for the Formula Junior Championship, with the grid split to put some of the earlier rear-engined cars in with the front-engined pack. Among the front-engined cars it is Justin Fleming (Lola Mk2) and Graham Barron in the Gemini who should set the pace, while the class C rear-engined cars will be topped by current champion Nic Carlton-Smith in his rare Kieft and Keith Pickering in

The later rear-engined cars have their own race and joining this grid will be FF2000 front runner Benn Simms in the rare Jim Blockley owned Caravelle Mk2.

However, the presence of young Michael O'Brien in a Brabham BT6 will set the bar very high as drivers like Clive Richard (Lotus 22), Tim Child (Lotus 22) and John Fyda (Brabham BT6) lead the chase.

Another strong grid comes from the 70s Road Sports Championship and features the welcome return of Cadwell ace and former champion Julian Barter in his TVR 3000M. Julian's rivals include his father Charles in his familiar Datsun 240Z and regular pacesetter Jeremy Clark in his Lotus Elan. Howard Payne (Lotus Europa), Adam Bagnall (Jaguar E-type) and Paul Tombs

(Lotus Europa) are among the other leading contenders in a strong grid, while Kevin Kivlochan makes a welcome return in his Morgan +8 after an engine disaster at Brands Hatch in April.

Back with single seaters, there is sure to be some tremendous competition in two races for the Historic Formula Ford 1600 Championship and the grid is headed by current pace setters Tom McArthur in his Titan Mk4 and Merlyn Mk20 racers Samuel Harrison and Callum Grant.

Danny Stanzl will chase them in his usual attacking style with his Elden Mk8.



The Classic Clubmans category has its next two races of the season and with regular pacesetter Mark Charteris not entered at the time of writing it is John Harrison who will surely set the pace from

fellow Mallock racers Adrian Holey, Alan Cook and Mike Lane. In the class for the Formula Ford engined cars category veteran Barry Webb will be very tough to beat.





Joining the weekend programme for a very welcome guest appearance is the DDMC Northern Saloon and Sports Car Championship with a fabulous array of more modern sports and saloon cars.

Stepping forward a generation in the Formula Fords will be two more races for the Classic Formula Ford Championship where Jordan Harrison, the current champion, is proving once again the man to beat in his Lola T540E.

Notable rivals include Rick Morris and his Royale RP29 and Tom McArthur, who switches to his Merlyn Mk20 for the Classic races.

The Historic Road Sports

category is another to have a race each day and it is Kivlochan who heads the entry in his mighty AC Cobra.

Although the Cobra is quite a handful around the twists and turns here at Cadwell, Kivlochan will be aiming to fend off the rapid Lotus Elans of Rupert Ashdown and Robert Rowe as well as the increasingly quick Morgan +8 of Jon Shaw.

The Historic Touring Car Championship will share a grid with the new Historic Modsports and Special Saloons field, which makes his debut with a modest grid of cars, including the Turner of Steve Watton, the Davrian Mk8 of Myles Castaldini and the Ford Escort Mk1 of Ronnie Haines.

In the Touring Car pack, trans-Atlantic commuter James Fuller makes a welcome return in his Alfa Romeo Giulia to take on the Lotus Cortinas of Nigel Cox and Mike Stephenson and the rapid Ford Anglia of Neil Wood.

Finally joining the weekend programme for a very welcome guest appearance is the wonderfully diverse and busy field in the DDMC Northern Saloon and Sports Car Championship, which has two races on Sunday for a fabulous array of more modern sports and saloon cars.







BLUE FLAG STATIONARY:

Another competitor is following close behind.

BLUE FLAG WAVED:

Another competitor is trying to overtake.



YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY:

Danger - Slow down, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG WAVED:

Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS WAVED:

Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD DISPLAYING SC:

Means that a Safety car is on track, slow down, no overtaking.

Yellow Flag signals may also be accompanied by flashing yellow lights as a repeat warning.



CODE 60:

Overtaking is not allowed and all drivers must slow their cars down to a maximum of 60 km/h (37 mph).



GREEN FLAG:

All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY:

Warning you are approaching an area with a slippery surface

YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED:

There is a slippery surface area within this sector.



RED FLAG:

Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.



WHITE FLAG STATIONARY:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

WHITE FLAG WAVED:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track..



BLACK FLAG:

The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the

The black flag is always displayed with a board showing the relevant competitors car number.



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect.

(i.e. track limits) And may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.



BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK FLAG:

Displayed with white number. Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver, call into pits immediately.



BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED:

End of race.


