HISTORIC RACING IN THE PARK

The championship season for some of the Historic Sports Car Club's core championships continues at Oulton Park on Saturday 6 August, a week after the high profile Gold Cup event.

PAUL LAWRENCE PREVIEWS THE ACTION





The HSCC is back at the Cheshire circuit for a one day race meeting on the fabulous International circuit with headline races including historic Formula Ford 1600, Historic Road Sports, 70s Road Sports and Historic Touring Cars.

Top of the bill will be two races for the Historic Formula Ford 1600 Championship, and it is Yorkshire teenager Samuel Harrison who is steadily tightening his grip on this year's title race.

With four wins from the last five races, Samuel is looking evermore like the champion elect although Tom McArthur, a local ace at Oulton Park, remains his prime challenger. If an entry from Tom in his Titan

Mk4 is confirmed, it will surely be another fierce contest. However, if Samuel can bag another brace of wins he will move ever closer to the title.

Other leading contenders include Over 50s pacesetter Rob Smith in his Merlyn Mk20, local racer Scott Rawlinson in his Merlyn Mk11 and Ross Drybrough in his rare March 709. Making a welcome return to the category after an absence of several years is local racer Nigel Bancroft in his Crossle 20F.

The 70s Road Sports contenders have a single longer race and it is Jez Clark who stands at the head of the points after another tremendous season so far in his Elan.

However, the pace of Charles Barter in his Datsun 240Z last time out at Brands Hatch was mighty, and Clark will have a big battle on his hands against his fellow former champion.

fine grid of pre '70 sports and GT cars headed by the AC Cobra of Kevin Kivlochan, which is due back out for the first time

following a bump at

Cadwell Park in early June.

The Morgan Plus 8s will be his main rivals, and at least four of them will be on the grid headed by Peter Garland and Tim Pearce, while the fastest of the Lotus Elans will include Jonathan Rose, Scottish visitor Jim Grant and Chris

Merrick.

The Classic Clubmans races will bring out a grid of the remarkably rapid front-engined sports racing cars and it is Mark Charteris who heads the field in his Mallock Mk20/21.

Mark unfortunately suffered a sizable accident last month in his Formula 2 March at Brands Hatch but will be fit and ready to again set the Clubmans pace at Oulton Park.

His rivals are likely to include John Harrison and Adrian Holey in similar cars, while in the class for Formula Ford engined cars young Tom Muirhead is setting the pace.

A welcome entry in the invitation class is local racer Mike Evans, an absolute Clubmans stalwart in his Mallock Mk27.

The Classic Formula 3 Championship features on the programme with a modest entry headed by the redoubtable Stephen Barlow in his Ralt RT3.

Stephen, a diver by profession, lives and works in Oban on the west coast of Scotland and makes vast journeys to get the chance to race his Ralt.

His pace last time out at Brands Hatch was mighty and he will surely be the man to beat this time around.

Historic Touring Cars are back on the bill with Mark Watts in his Ford Mustang heading a field that includes Neil Wood's rapid Ford Anglia and Harry Barton in his BMW 1800. Barton has been a prolific racer this season and was in action in two races at the Gold Cup.

Sharing the grid with the Historic Touring Cars will be the cars in the fledgling HSCC Historic Modsports and Special Saloons category, which is having the second of two pilot races this season ahead of a fuller programme next year. More cars are joining the grid already and it was Steve Watton (Turner) and Myles Castaldini (Davrian) who made the running at Cadwell Park.

They will be joined by the Mazda RX7 of Mark Spence and the very rapid TVR Griffith of Nigel Reuben in a promising field for this new series.

FLAG SIGNALS



BLUE FLAG STATIONARY:

Another competitor is following close behind.

BLUE FLAG WAVED:

Another competitor is trying to overtake.



YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY:

Danger - Slow down, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG WAVED:

Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS WAVED:

Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD DISPLAYING SC:

Means that a Safety car is on track, slow down, no overtaking.

Yellow Flag signals may also be accompanied by flashing yellow lights as a repeat warning.



CODE 60:

Overtaking is not allowed and all drivers must slow their cars down to a maximum of 60 km/h (37 mph).



GREEN FLAG:

All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY:

Warning you are approaching an area with a slippery surface

YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED:

There is a slippery surface area within this sector.



RED FLAG:

Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.



WHITE FLAG STATIONARY:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

WHITE FLAG WAVED:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track..



BLACK FLAG:

The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the

The black flag is always displayed with a board showing the relevant competitors car number.



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect.

(i.e. track limits) And may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.



BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK FLAG:

Displayed with white number. Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver, call into pits immediately.



BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED:

End of race.
