

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THE 2023 RACING SEASON STARTS IN

The 2023 racing season from the Historic Sports Car Club starts in style at Snetterton this weekend with a full programme of racing topped by the return of the Autosport 3 Hours race for pre '66 GT cars.

PAUL LAWRENCE PREVIEWS THE ACTION



Whilst Saturday's race action runs on the full 300 circuit at the Norfolk venue, on Sunday the racing switches to the shorter 200 circuit and it is here that the Autosport 3 Hours will run with a tremendous entry of GT cars.

Heading the field and likely to set the outright pace is the mighty TVR
Griffith of Ollie Rubin and Harry
Barton. However, a gaggle of rapid
smaller engined cars will give strong
pursuit, including a clutch of Lotus
Elans with drivers like Martin Stretton.

Horatio Fitz-Simon and Nigel Greensall at the wheel to ensure some tremendous racing.

A special award will go to the leading MGB in the race while a fantastically varied grid also takes in Austin Healey 3000s, Lotus Elites, Porsche 911s, TVR Granturas and Gilberns. It promises to be a fine contest with lots of action and pit crews working hard to get the best result for their car.

A number of HSCC season-long championships open at Snetterton, notably the Historic Formula Ford 2000 Championship, which has a fantastic grid for two races. With last year's champion Benn Simms switching back to Historic Formula Ford for now, the way is open for Graham Fennymore to head the FF2000 pack. In a strong field his

rivals include Ian Pearson (Royale RP30), Marc Mercer, Greg Robertson, Oli Roberts, and category graduate Jordan Harrison, who steps up from winning Classic Formula Ford to race a Lola T580 on his slicks and wings debut.

Simms, meanwhile, is in a very strong entry for the opening two rounds of the Historic Formula Ford
Championship, where he has plenty of opposition as he brings his Jomo JMR7 back out after a lengthy rebuild.
Matthew Wrigley, Simon Toyne, Ross Drybrough Will Nuthall, Cormac Flanagan, Callum Grant, Danny Stanzl and Linton Stutely are all ferociously competitive and will ensure some fantastic racing.

Historic Formula Junior opens up with a bumper grid of more than 30 cars





The Modsports and Special Saloon grid is very encouraging in the early stages of this new category... for a single race on Saturday, covering both front and rear engined designs. Fresh from a starring role in recent HGPCA races in his F1 Brabham, Tim Child returns to his Lotus 22 to take on the similar cars of Clive Richards and Horatio Fitz-Simon while Nick Fennel has his stunning Lotus 27 on the grid.

Mark Woodhouse makes a welcome return to Formula Junior in his Lotus 20/22 and among the front engined cars Alex Morton in the Condor will be one of the drivers to beat.

Opening the race action will be a joint race for the Historic Road Sports
Championship and the new HSCC
Historic Modsports and Special
Saloons category. Both have turned out good grids and in the Road Sports division it is the Morgan Plus 8s of

William Plant and John Shaw which will strive to take the battle to the mighty Shelby Cobra of Kevin Kivlochan.

The Modsports and Special Saloon grid is very encouraging in the early stages of this new category with at least 10 cars due out, including the rapid Maguire Stiletto of Paul Knapton, Peter Halford's Ford Boss Mustang, Paul Sibley's MG Midget and the Davrians of Myles Castaldini and Ian McBay.

Sharing a grid will be the two-litre slicks and wings single seaters from Classic Formula 3, Historic Formula Atlantic and Classic FF2000. Samuel Harrison's Formula Atlantic Lola T240 should set the pace and in pursuit will be the rapid FF2000 Van Diemens of Ben Styles and Amnon Needham.

The 70s Road Sports Championship gets underway with a grid including the Morgan Plus 8 of Kevin Kivlochan, who really should set the pace on the





Another HSCC championship making its 2023 debut is the Classic Formula Ford Championship with an excellent grid of pre '82 Formula Fords including category veterans Rick Morris and Stuart Kestenbaum. Jake Shortland will field the rare but effective Lola T440, while two more highly experienced racers in the category are Simon Davey and Nigel Lingwood in Van Diemen RF80s.

Adding to the weekend are guest races from the Monoposto Racing Club, with two bumper grids of single seaters from the 1980s, '90s and early 2000s.

After a full day on the 300 circuit on Saturday, racing will switch to the 200 circuit on Sunday and those categories that have not qualified on the 200 circuit will have three laps behind the safety car on their way to the grid to familiarise themselves with the alternative layout.

PAUL LAWRENCE PREVIEWS THE ACTION



The race has proved attractive to those who normally compete in the HSCC's Guards Trophy as well as a range of other championships and series. The Club was keen to welcome competitors who wanted to tackle this one-off endurance contest and cars from a range of categories are all eligible for the race.

The three-hour contest is open to two or more drivers per car with pit stops and special refuelling arrangements.

"We have been looking to bring this race back onto the schedule in tribute to the original Autosport Three Hours, and we felt that this was a good time to re-launch it at our annual Snetterton race meeting.

"I'm very pleased to report that we have attracted a wide range of GT cars of all engine capacities, including some that do not normally race with the HSCC. Everyone has been made very welcome for this one off race."

BACKGROUND

This will be the 18th running of a famous race that began in the late 1950s. In period, Jim Clark (twice) and Jack Sears were winners while in more recent times winners have included Simon Hadfield, Chris Ward and Martin O'Connell.

After an eight-year sabbatical, the race is being brought back to the historic racing calendar and will be for GT cars, as it was in the late 1950s and early 1960s. The 2023 winners will join the illustrious list of former winners, a list topped by Jim Clark.

The race is open to all owners and drivers of Pre '66 GT cars, regardless of whether or not they normally race with the HSCC. The spirit of the race will be friendly, sporting and inclusive. High standards of on- and off-track behaviour will be expected and enforced.

TEAM COMPETITION

Entrants are encouraged to form teams of three cars – each car must be from a different class. The team with the best combined overall performance will be presented with a special trophy.

PRIZE GIVING

All race awards will be presented as soon as possible after the race at the post-race celebrations (location to be confirmed) with drinks available for all drivers and team members, garlands, interviews and a great atmosphere. All spectators are most welcome to attend.

CLASSES & AWARDS

The overall winners will receive the Autosport 3 Hours Trophy and there will be awards for each class winner. The grid will be divided into classes as follows:

A: Standard, competition GT & GT prototype cars up to 2500cc (excluding metal-bodied cars)

B Metal-bodied standard & competition GT cars up to 2000cc

C All standard competition GT and GT prototype cars 2001 to 4000cc

D All standard competition GT & GT prototype cars over 4000cc

E All standard competition GT & GT prototype cars up to 1300cc

REFUELLING

There will be an on-site fuel supply service via Anglo American Oil

Refuelling is only permitted in the pit lane outside the allocated pit garage for each entrant.

Each car will be required to make a minimum of two five-minute pit stops during the race. At each mandatory pit stop the car must remain stationary for a minimum of five minutes even if the car is not being refuelled.

There is no pit stop window for this race.

MGB CELEBRATED

The racing MGB will be celebrated during this weekend's Autosport Three Hour race.

To celebrate 60 years of the iconic British sports car, the HSCC is awarding a special trophy for the best performance from an MGB in the Autosport Three Hour. The HSCC 'B' Trophy will be presented to the first MGB across the line at the end of what promises to be a fantastic three-hour endurance contest.

MGBs continue to be one of the most affordable and accessible ways of getting into historic racing and are a perfect fit for the HSCC ethos of great value historic racing. The 'B' has long been a stalwart of HSCC race meetings, notably running in Historic Road Sports and 70s Road Sports as well as the GT section of the Guards Trophy.



Andy Dee-Crowne, CEO of the HSCC, said: "We're delighted with how the grid has built for the return of the Autosport Three Hour. While we have a fantastic trophy for the overall race winners, we also wanted to celebrate the strong support we've had from MGB racers and decided to present a rather nice award to the leading MGB. This unique trophy is our way of acknowledging the contribution of the MGB to the on-going success of historic motor racing."

With more than half a million road cars built between 1962 and 1980, the MGB remains one of Britain's most successful and popular sports cars and, in race trim, continues to offer tremendous value for money racing for dozens of owners.

The first race weekend for the newest series to join the HSCC portfolio of categories is here at Snetterton. Drivers will be competing over the season for the John Fletcher Trophy (Modsports) and the Peter Baldwin Trophy (Saloons).

The concept behind Historic Modsports and Special Saloons is to re-create a period of national racing history from the late 1960s and 1970s and to attract back into racing the type of cars that packed out Modified Sports and Special Saloon Car grids in period. Eligible cars will be those that comply with specific period MSA 'Blue Book' regulations for Modsports and Special Saloons from the 1970's.

Cars with spaceframe chassis are permitted in the Saloons, but for Modsports the original chassis or unitary construction must remain between the wheel hub centres. Any two valves per cylinder engine from the period can be transplanted into other cars, but engines with four valves per cylinder can only run in cars originally homologated with them.

The regulations allow periodstyle changes to the transmission, bodywork, brakes and suspension. In order to keep the series in line with the cars of the period, no modern (post 1980) engines, no motorcycle engines, no sequential gearboxes, no Lotus/Caterham Seven type cars and no kit car replicas are permitted.

Chase Equipment is supplying awards for the winners, including a separate 'Champion of the Meeting' award for

the Modsports car and the Special Saloon car with the quickest elapsed time over the two races combined, along with garlands and a bottle of Moet & Chandon Champagne for the winners of each race. Chase Equipment is one of the leading suppliers in their industry.



BLUE FLAG STATIONARY:

Another competitor is following close behind.

BLUE FLAG WAVED:

Another competitor is trying to overtake.



YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY:

Danger - Slow down, no overtaking.

YELLOW FLAG WAVED:

Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS WAVED:

Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD DISPLAYING SC:

Means that a Safety car is on track, slow down, no overtaking.

Yellow Flag signals may also be accompanied by flashing yellow lights as a repeat warning.



CODE 60:

Overtaking is not allowed and all drivers must slow their cars down to a maximum of 60 km/h (37 mph).



GREEN FLAG:

All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY:

Warning you are approaching an area with a slippery surface

YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED:

There is a slippery surface area within this sector.



RED FLAG:

Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.



WHITE FLAG STATIONARY:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

WHITE FLAG WAVED:

A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track..



BLACK FLAG:

The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the

The black flag is always displayed with a board showing the relevant competitors car number.



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect.

(i.e. track limits) And may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.



BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK FLAG:

Displayed with white number. Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver, call into pits immediately.



BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED:

End of race.
