The food and drink will be subsidised by Yokohama and there should be ample for everyone. If we all park in the allocated spaces as indicated on the Paddock Plan it should work really well.

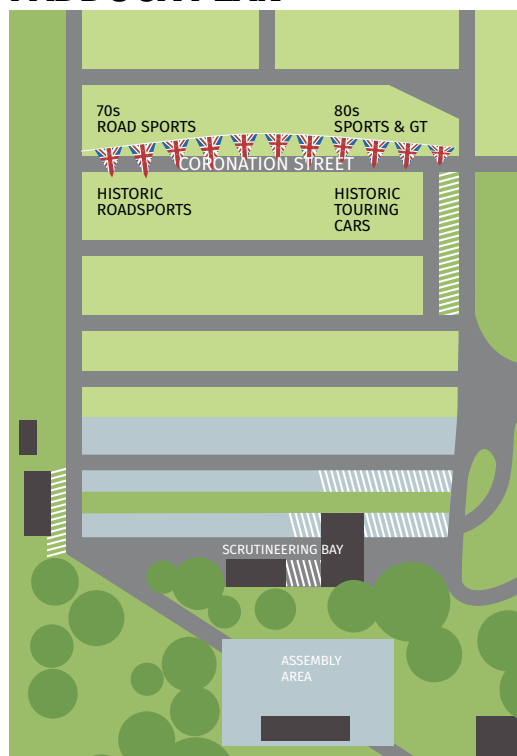
We have also placed an order for a large quantity of Coronation Cup Cakes and are planning for tea and coffee to be available throughout the weekend.
