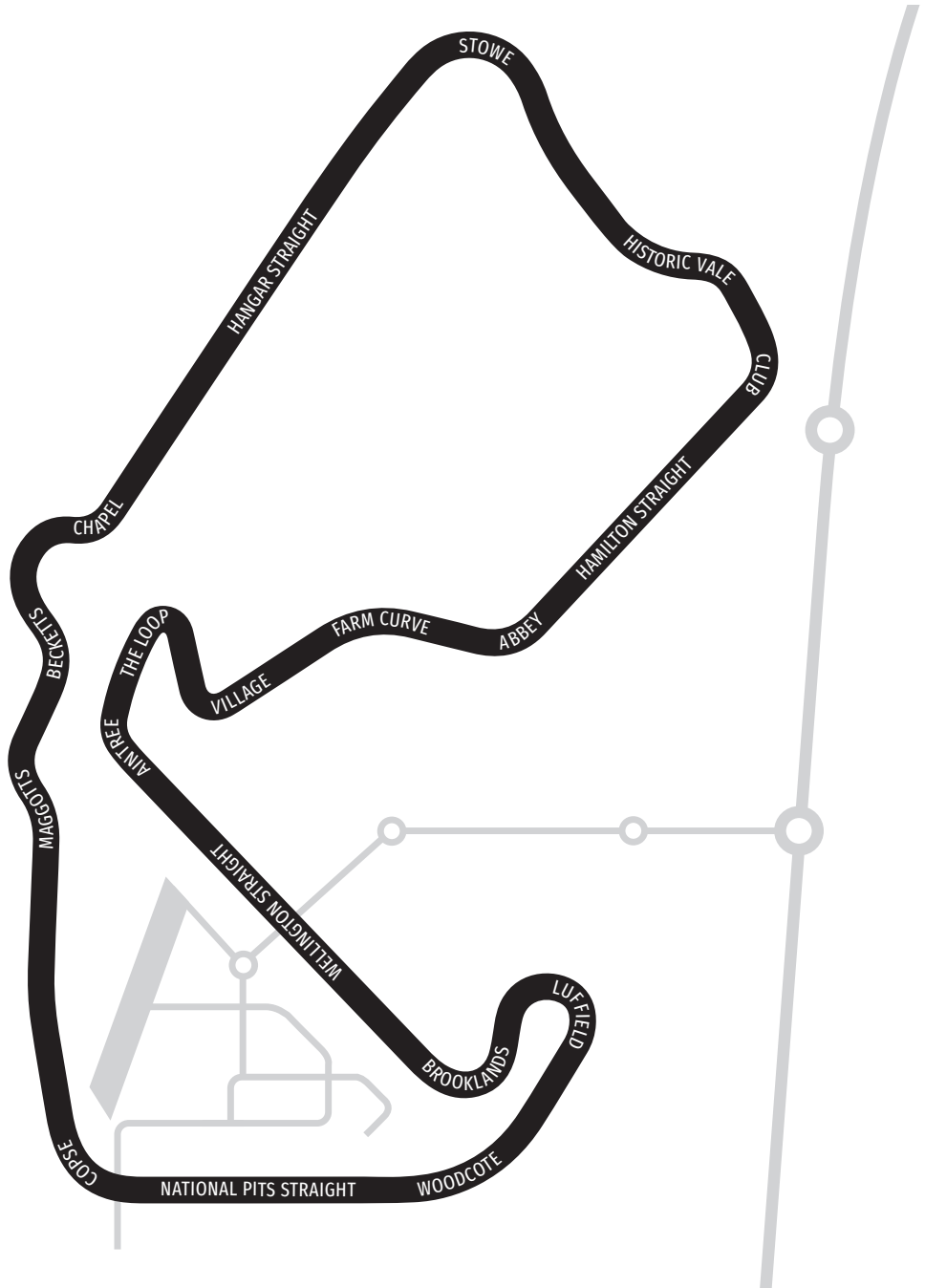

# HSCC INTERNATIONAL TROPHY

Quality and quantity for International Trophy weekend

The HSCC Historic Formula 2 International Series headlines this weekend's Silverstone International Trophy race weekend on the full Grand Prix circuit.

PAUL LAWRENCE PREVIEWS THE ACTION



The International trophy tag pays homage to one of the most famous races held at Silverstone over the years.

With a total of 360 entries, it promises to be a fabulous weekend of historic racing at the Historic Sports Car Club's home circuit of Silverstone. It is undoubtedly one of the flagship events in the Club's annual race calendar.

The International trophy tag pays homage to one of the most famous races held at Silverstone over the years and a race that has an F2 history at times. Heading a quality grid of these fantastic pre '79 single seaters will be drivers of the calibre of Matthew Watts, Mark Charteris, Matthew Wrigley, David Thorburn and Martin Wood all in Marches of various

age. Flying the flag for Ralt will be Marc Mercer and Greg Audi, while Chevron, Lotus and Elfin are all represented in a quality field.

With more than 60 period Formula Fords entered, it will be a great weekend for Formula Ford history with a 36-car grid for the next two rounds of the Historic FF 1600 Championship. The season opened with two fabulous races at Snetterton and there's every reason to expect more of the same on the Silverstone Grand Prix circuit where a gaggle of front runners will do battle.

Benn Simms, Matthew Wrigley, Will Nuthall, Callum Grant, Sam Mitchell and Linton Stutely are all potential winners.

The Classic Formula Ford race is equally strong with support from SDC and features front runners including Snetterton winner Joseph Ahrens, Rick Morris, Mike Gardner and Ben Tinkler in a grid that includes a welcome group of newcomers to the category.

Another bumper grid will contest the Guards Trophy along with a selection of Thundersports cars. Chevrons

dominate though the later B16s, which have been admitted to the Guards grid for the first time this year, will have a longer pitstop to ensure that the earlier B8s and B6s remain just as competitive as ever. From the B8 ranks come Sandy Watson Mark Owen, Christian Pittard, David Forsbrey and Steve Nuttall while John Sheldon, Ross Hyett and Steve Hodges head the B16s. In the GT section of the Guards Trophy Horatio Fitz-Simon will be among the pace setters in his Lotus Elan 26R. Topping the Thundersports Pack should be the Osella PA2 of David Alborough.

The Aurora Trophy and Classic Formula 3 field is strong with a fine range of rapid single seaters, including the thundering Formula 5000s of Frank Lyons, Christian Pittard, Mike Coker and Matthew Wurr along

with the very quick Formula Atlantic Ralt RT4 of Rory Smith. From the Formula 3 ranks, Richard Trott and Stephen Barlow are notable contenders.

A vast grid for a combined 70s/ Historic Road Sports and Historic Touring Car field will run on Saturday and picking a winner will be incredibly difficult with such an array of cars.



The Morgan +8s may well be able to stretch their legs to good effect in the hands of Kevin Kivlochan, Will Plant and John Shaw but they face a gaggle of rapid Lotus Elans, the Porsche 911SC of John Williams and several TVR 3000Ms. Mark Watts is likely to set the place from the Touring Car ranks in his Ford Mustang.

With two races on Sunday, a nice grid of 50s drum brakes sports cars will contest the Griffiths Haig Trophy. John Ure's splendid Cooper Bristol will be up there along with the glorious

Maserati 250S of Richard Wilson, the Allard J2X of Simon and Gareth Evans and the thundering Kurtis 500 of Chris Keen.

Adding tremendously to the weekend are three guest grids including the Monoposto Championship, with over 50 recent single seaters doing battle. From the Classic Sports Car Club come two grids, including a huge Swinging 60s field and a very strong Classic K grid to add mini endurance races to a quality weekend of historic racing.

# CSCC Mintex Classic K

First started in 2010, the Mintex Classic K series is for pre 1966 GT and Touring cars running to FIA Appendix K, with no sports racing cars.



This is competitive racing, balanced with a degree of common sense regarding eligibility and an expectation of high driving standards. To ensure close, fair racing we expect cars to conform to their FIA papers, but do allow cars to enter with out of date papers and on occasion cars that may not have been homologated, but race in period specification on the correct Dunlop tyres.

At the time of writing there are 35 of these beautiful cars entered. Whilst the attention is naturally at the front end of the grid, do look for battles within class too. Class M, for MGB's is one of the most popular and competitive categories, with no less than 14 entered.

Reliability is always a factor on 60 year old cars, but this shorter than usual, 40 minute race will help in that regard. The trio of TVR Griffith's will

really stretch their legs here on the GP circuit, possibly that grunt being just a little too much for the always competitive Elan's.

Jamie Boot is perhaps the favourite, by a nose. Luke Wos, in the diminutive class E Turner always punches above it's weight, at round 1 at Snetterton the Turner was certainly giving the Elan's something to think about.

The trio of Mini's will put on a great show through Brooklands and Luffield in particular, where the change of direction may see their back-ends luridly sliding, giving heavier cars something to worry about in their mirrors.

With neither of our previous round winners present today, this is a pure race to the flag, punctuated only by a 1 minute 30 second mandatory pit-stop, timed from pit-in to pit-out.



# CSCC Adams & Page Swinging Sixties



This is the CSCC's longest running race series, now in its 20th year. On the run up to this event, the 61 car grid was full with a list of reserves, inevitably members have had to withdraw as we've drawn closer, such is the fragility and parts availability of these older, tuned cars.

Compared to many other categories on display over this weekend, the Adams & Page Swinging 60s does allow a degree of freedom when it comes to tuning and fettling.

The series has four main rules: the engine block and head must be the same original type that was fitted in period, showroom silhouette, no forced induction, whilst tyres must either be a tall profile Yokohama, or the slower Dunlop crossply. This produces a wide cross-section of performances, in some cases far exceeding the wildest dreams of the manufacturer in the 60s. A mandatory 'quick-as-you-can' pit stop always shakes things up, mid-way through the race.

Over the years the series has grown that at most circuits it is split into two groups, with separate races for both, with class trophies to fight for too.

The more powerful Group 2 cars will be quicker on the full GP circuit. Our tip for the win must be Halstead/Eagling, making a return to the series in

the featherweight Ginetta. Raymond Barrow and his brute of a Camaro could take overall Group 2 honours, but Jon Wolfe (TVR Tuscan) will be close by, proving his pace with pole position at Thruxton last month, before mechanical issues struck.

Group 1 has at least ten contenders for overall glory! Connor Kay and his MG Midget will be quick in the first half, until he is required to serve a 20 sec. winners penalty at the pit-stop, following his win at Thruxton. Ian Staines with his trusty blue MG Midget will be fast if the car holds together for him.

Family teams are both welcomed and successful with the CSCC, father and son, Steve/Jack Smith will be one of the quickest, in their sleek MGA, whilst father and daughter Charles Tippet/Claire Norman will hope to get further than the first lap they managed at Thruxton, in their well-driven BMW 2002ti. Further back, it's brilliant to see oddities, such as the Tunnard pairings Fairthorpe Electron.

Profits are shared among 400 members of staff and the wider community.

SDC has a long involvement with Formula Ford dating back to the early 1980s when the company supported drivers like Trevor van Rooyen, David Wheeler, John Village, Jonathan Palmer, Gareth Rees and Bernard Dolan in a series of Formula Fords.

Last year, SDC celebrated its 50th year and supported Richard Tarling in a Royale RP26 and a Crossle 25F in the Classic championship.

For 2023, SDC has turned its attention to backing the entire championship and the support will allow every driver to receive a £75 rebate on each race entry this season.

Stuart Kestenbaum is chair of the Classic FF 1600 Championship and says that the support is very welcome. “We are certainly getting more entries and we are close to 30 cars this weekend at Silverstone, which is a great grid. Entry fees are the one thing that everyone is unanimous about and we’ve taken the pricing back about 10 years thanks to the support of SDC.”

SDC chairman Francis Shiner explained the company’s support: “Formula Ford is an important part of our history and we have quite a few of our staff interested in racing. But it’s more of an emotional involvement for us rather than traditional sponsorship. We did a lot of work at Silverstone over the years and that was a really big part of the company story.

“Later we completed construction projects for Jonathan Palmer at Bedford and supported local drivers like Nick Tandy. We plan to take a number of guests to the two race meetings at Silverstone in May and October. It fits that we have a couple of days at Silverstone and give something to our staff.” An F1 simulator will be taken to those two events to give five staff a chance at trying it for themselves.

Alan Cornock, who was central to the SDC sponsorship 40 years ago, has played a key role in bringing the company back into Formula Ford racing. As the former boss of Royale racing cars, Cornock continues to be closely involved in Formula Ford through his FCS sales and spares organisation.

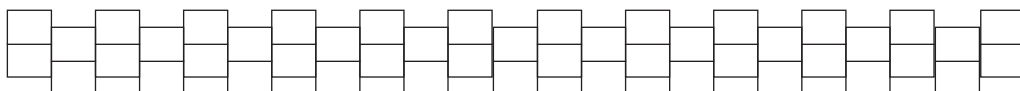

# FLAG SIGNALS



## **BLUE FLAG STATIONARY:**

Another competitor is following close behind.

## **BLUE FLAG WAVED:**

Another competitor is trying to overtake.



## **YELLOW FLAG STATIONARY:**

Danger – Slow down, no overtaking.

## **YELLOW FLAG WAVED:**

Danger – slow down sufficiently to ensure full control of your vehicle, no overtaking.

## **DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS WAVED:**

Great danger – slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary.

## **YELLOW FLAG SIGNALS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A WHITE BOARD DISPLAYING SC:**

Means that a Safety car is on track, slow down, no overtaking.

Yellow Flag signals may also be accompanied by flashing yellow lights as a repeat warning.



## **CODE 60:**

Overtaking is not allowed and all drivers must slow their cars down to a maximum of 60 km/h (37 mph).



## **GREEN FLAG:**

All clear at the end of a cautionary Sector, or following a Safety car, to denote the incident is clear. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and show to all posts on the first lap of practice or the formation lap of a race.



## **YELLOW/RED STRIPES STATIONARY:**

Warning you are approaching an area with a slippery surface

## **YELLOW/RED STRIPES WAVED:**

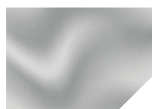
There is a slippery surface area within this sector.



## **RED FLAG:**

Stop racing and proceed slowly to the pits or startline as directed by the Marshals.

Red Flag can be accompanied by red lights around the circuit as a repeat warning.



## **WHITE FLAG STATIONARY:**

A slow moving car or service vehicle is on the circuit.

## **WHITE FLAG WAVED:**

A slow moving car or service vehicle is within this sector of the track..



## **BLACK FLAG:**

The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the

The black flag is always displayed with a board showing the relevant competitors car number.



## **BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL FLAG:**

Accompanied by a board with the drivers number on. A warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect. (i.e. track limits) And may incur a penalty or be black flagged if further reports are received.



## **BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK FLAG:**

Displayed with white number. Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver, call into pits immediately.



## **BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED:**

End of race.
