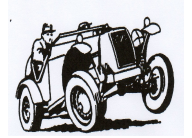




Midlands Trials Car Club Heritage Trial 2023



Supplementary Regulations

1. Midlands Trials Car Club will organise a Clubman's Heritage Trial at Blackmoor Farm, Woolminstone, Crewkerne, Somerset, TA18 8QP on **Saturday 16th September 2023**
2. This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. Motorsports UK Permit No. TBC
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and BTRDA, NPTCC, 750 Motor Club, MCC, HSCC, VSCC, MAC, Stroud and District MC, KBCC, Southsea Motor Club Ltd, Woolbridge MC, Falcon Motor Club, Dellow Register and Golden Valley HLCC
5. All drivers and passengers must produce a valid MSUK competition licence (minimum RS Clubmans) and be a member of a MSUK registered motor club.
6. Scrutineering starts at 9.30am, its location will be defined in the final instructions.
7. First hill at 10.30am. Any competitor who has not collected their onsite number and scorecard pack by 10.15am may be excluded.
8. The trial will consist of at least three rounds of at least six hills. The entry will be split into groups starting on different hills. Start

hills will be determined by ballot. No practicing on the sections will be allowed. Competition numbers will be issued by the organisers. **Double drives** and **shared drives** are permitted– each driver must submit an entry form.

9. Classes: -

Class 1: HERITAGE Class: Post war cars of a type which would have competed in sporting trials prior to the end of 1956 e.g., original Dellows, original trials specials etc. These vehicles must be largely in original period specification e.g., 1172 engine/gearbox/rear axle. Period modifications such as alternative head, additional carburettor, supercharger, hydraulic brakes are acceptable.

Class 2: MODIFIED HERITAGE class: Post war cars of a type which would have competed in sporting trials prior to the end of 1956 e.g., modified Dellows, modified trials specials etc. These vehicles may have later sympathetic period modifications but only using components first manufactured before the end of 1969. Modifications such as non-period frame, engine, gearbox, axles. suspension, dampers, disc brakes, fuel injection, engine management systems will move the car into the Invitation class.

- **Class 3: VSCC eligible cars / Short wheelbase**
- **Class 4: VSCC eligible cars/Long wheelbase**
- **Class 5: Invitation class:** Open period trials cars that do not conform to the other classes but may be considered by the organisers as acceptable within the spirit of the meeting.

10. Awards: Awards will be presented to the drivers who finish 1st and 2nd in each class subject to a minimum of four starters in each class. Organisers reserve the right to reallocate awards.
11. The maximum entry for the meeting is 65; if entries exceed this number, entries will be accepted on a 'first come, first served' basis. The minimum is 20, should the minimum number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.
12. Entries opens on the publication of the S.Rs and closes at 23.59pm on Saturday 9th September 2023. Entries must be made on the official entry form and the entry fee must be paid at least 24 hours in advance of the event, payment will not be accepted on the day. Entries will be refunded in full with 24 hours' notice or cancellation of the event.
