

Regulation Changes

The regulations have remained in the main static and I don't see them moving from now on, so anyone building a new car to enter with us, will have to comply with those. There has been a slight change in that original mechanical injection is allowed but cannot be on any modern electronic engine management system.

On occasion, cars may be 'invited' to compete, but they will not be eligible for awards.

Original Period Cars

Cars which raced in period and remain in a specification which could have taken place in period, so no modern 'equivalent' chassis, engines, gearboxes, fuelling, brakes etc.. Will be welcome to apply for eligibility. When granted, they will be allotted a class to compete in. We still retain the right to review their inclusion depending on the performance factors of each car.

Once Again Thank You

The Historic Modsports and Special Saloon series created by the HSCC has gathered tremendous momentum through the 2023 season, with a considerable number of cars being resurrected and more being prepared for the 2024 season.

We think 2024 provides a real opportunity for the series to continue to grow. The economic climate is difficult I know, I work full time to fund this hobby of mine and value every penny I spend. There are cost increases, which we have no control over, in particular, circuit charges, these have been contested, but until there is a step change in the way racing is organised in the UK there is no option. The racing membership for the HSCC has increased, but don't forget, this is all you pay, series registration is included within racing membership with the HSCC, other clubs have a lower initial membership fee, but then charge an extra fee for racing registration for each series.

I see that 14 of you have already joined the HSCC and registered for the series for 2024, taking advantage of the discounted fee offered for those doing so in January.

Finally, I would like to thank every single one of you for your support, whether a racer or as a supporter, mechanic, journalist or photographer, it is the whole community we are building which helps to give this series the identity it is rapidly developing.

This series also offers a unique place to come and race your car, and be certain that only cars of a similar period specification are going to be alongside you. There are some other very good series where I've no doubt you would be welcome, but none with the same level of Historic significance as this. This is being recognised within the sport and more and more original iconic cars are swelling our grids. Which is something we need to continue with, especially now we are a stand-alone series.

I'm looking forward to catching up with many of you at the lunch on the 24th, but if you're unable to make that, then hopefully at the first round at Snetterton. By the way, entries open on the 23rd Feb.
