Please do not leave any cables or hoses across walkways. Use the cable ducts provided, or cable matting. No tailgates may remain open into the access road whether they are raised or not. Please make yourself familiar with the garage, paddock, and pit rules. If you have any issues of concern or see any hazards, please report them to race control.
