

## **Supplementary Regulations**

- 1.**The Historic Sports Car Club** will promote an Interclub Race Meeting on the National Circuit (length 1.639 miles) at Silverstone on Saturday 1st November and Sunday 2nd November 2025.
- 2. **The Meeting** will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (MSUK) (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the Organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3. Permit Number: TBC Status Interclub...
- 4. **Eligibility:** The Meeting is open to all invited competitors with an eligible car (please contact the HSCC Office to check the eligibility of your car). Interclub or above status licence is required for all races. Club or above status licence are required for all races unless otherwise notified on Championship/Series Regulations. Or be in possession pf the highest grade of national Race licence or valid FIA International Licence, together with their ASN's written consent NCR 6.3.1.6 and FIA ISC Article 2.3.7.b applies).
- 5. Races: The Meeting will consist of races for the following categories of cars:
  - A. **Walter Hayes Trophy for 1600cc Formula Ford.** This is run over a series of qualifying heats from where competitors graduate to a series of elimination races which lead to Semi Finals and a Final. There will be separate Finals for eligible cars built prior to 31.12.82 (Carl Hamer Trophy) and 1982 1992 (Janet Cesar Trophy)
  - B. **Reprise IT Tiedeman Trophy:** for single seater cars in classes conforming to the Championship listed in the Regulations.
  - C. Ginetta Junior Winter Series
  - D. **Hitek Alfa Romeo & Italian Intermarque Championship :** For cars and competitors registered for the Championship
  - E. **Walter Hayes 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Allcomers Closed Wheel Challenge for cars** conforming to HSCC Championships/Series Regulations for closed wheel cars & other production based cars pre 1990 plus later cars all by invitation.
  - F. **Signing on & Scrutineering:** Signing on will be by Pre-Event declaration. Scrutineering will take place 31<sup>st</sup> October, 1st & 2nd November at times and location as described in the event Final Instructions. All vehicles must comply with their championship or series regulations.
- 6.**Starts**: Races will be either standing or rolling starts as stated in the Final Instructions. Grid formation will be 1x1 for single seaters and 2x2 for all other cars. Grid positions will be determined by practice times.
- 7. **Signalling Lights:** There are signalling lights at various locations around the circuit. These lights are the primary means of communication they have the same meaning and authority as flags.
- 8. **Qualifying:** There will be only one Qualifying session for each category of race. Drivers must complete 3 laps to qualify for a place on the grid. Drivers who are allowed to qualify out of session will start from the back of the grid.
- 9. Numbers: All vehicles must display numbers and roundels in accordance with Motorsport UK regulations.
- 10.**Pits:** Cars entering the Pits during practice or racing must use the Pit Entry Road. Failure to observe Pit marshal's lawful instructions may lead to exclusion from the Meeting.
- 11.**Judges,** who will be deemed to be Judges of Fact, will be appointed to adjudicate on Track Limits, noise, false/jumped starts, finishing order, crossing a penalty line and flag contraventions.

- 12. Entries will open on 8<sup>th</sup> September and will close at 17:00 hrs on Tuesday 28th October The Organisers reserve the right to select or refuse entries. Entry for all races will be online. For Walter Hayes Trophy to enter go to TBA For the Tiedeman Trophy go to TBA Ginetta Juniors go to TBA . For the HSCC Races go to <a href="https://hscc.org.uk/events/">https://hscc.org.uk/events/</a>. Refunds for racing testing refunds will be at the discretion of the payment holder i.e. Silverstone Circuits Ltd or Monoposto Racing Club or Ginetta Winter Series. Correctly filled-in entries, with the correct entry fee, will be acknowledged electronically. Reserves will be accepted in accordance with circuit capacity. The maximum number of starters for the Meeting will be 500 and the minimum 120. The maximum number of starters per race will be as per the Motorsport UK Track Licence and the minimum is 15. If these numbers are not reached the Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate races.
- 13.**Silencing.** All cars must be fitted with a silencer if their Series or Championship Regulations require, i.e. silencers must be fitted to all Formula Fords contesting the Walter Hayes Trophy, Monoposto IT Tiedman Trophy, Ginetta Winter Series Alfa Romeo and Italian Intermarque Championship. For both HSCC Allcomers Closed Wheel races the car must comply with Motorsport UK and/or the Championship or Series Regulations in which the car regularly competes.
- 14.**Tyres.** For races B E in these Supplementary Regulations, the tyre choice is as per the regulations of the Championship or Series in which the car currently competes.
- 15. Entry Fees: As per Entry Forms.

The Walter Hayes Trophy meeting is being organised by the HSCC on behalf of Silverstone Circuits Ltd ("SCL"), Silverstone Circuit, Towcester, Northamptonshire, NN12 8TN for whom they are acting as agents. The race entry fees quoted includes VAT at 20%. SCL is registered in England, No. 882843. SCL's VAT registration number is GB 119 7927 34.

- 16.**Nominated Drivers**: Driver nominations may be deferred but under no circumstances may a driver compete without signing the appropriate indemnity declaration NCR 6.1.2.1).
- 17.**The Organisers** reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Meeting or any part thereof. In the event of postponement, abandonment or cancellation, the Organisers and Promoters will not be liable for any loss or expense incurred by Entrants or Drivers.
